



COLE HARBOUR MINOR BASEBALL ASSOCIATION REFUND POLICY

CHMBA understands that mitigating circumstances can affect a family during the registration period. With this in mind CHMBA has set forward the following guidelines for registration refunds:

1. Baseball Nova Scotia charges CHMBA a non-refundable \$10.00 insurance fee for every registration, which is included in the registration dues. Therefore, CHMBA will deduct this cost prior to the surcharge calculation of the refund.
2. The \$10.00 tryout fee, which is added to the general registration dues for those wishing to participate in tryouts, is not part of the general seasonal expenses of the organization. This fee is utilized immediately for overall costs associated with the preparation and selection of the organizations "rep" teams prior to the start of the season. For this reason, the tryout fee is also deemed non-refundable and CHMBA will deduct this cost prior to the surcharge calculation of the refund.
3. Refunds, if allowable, will be paid out within two weeks of the player's initial registration funds clearing the organizations bank account.

Registration refunds may be requested at any time and, if allowable, are subject to a surcharge which is reflected by the percentage of the organizations costs on the following timeline:

4. Requests made on or before May 15th are refunded at 90%
5. Requests made on or before June 10th are refunded at 50%
6. No refunds will be given after June 10th.

REFUND FOR INJURED PLAYERS (appended July 9, 2006)

CHMBA will also consider a refund in the case of a serious injury which prevents a player from completing the current baseball season. The injury may be one occurring either on the ball field or outside of the playing field and must be supported by a medical certificate.

The amount of the refund will be determined by the Executive and will be based on the date of the injury and the time remaining in the season up to a maximum of a 50% refund. The guidelines (#1-3) outlined in the general Refund Policy statement will also apply.
