

## UMPIRE INFORMATION FOR COACHES

- All correspondence (cancellations, etc) with the assigner should be done by phone (469-4691).
- The exception would be tournament schedules which should be sent out by e mail ([kghartling@hotmail.com](mailto:kghartling@hotmail.com)) at least 1 week before the tournament starts.
- Cancellations of games should be done at least 2 hours before game time.
- When booking Umpires for rescheduled games, teams must give the Assigner at least forty-eight (48) hours notice of the requirements.
- If there is only one umpire at the game, find out his/her name and let the assigner know.
- Also let the assigner know if the umpire(s) do not show up on time or other problems so that action can be taken.

### Umpire Payment Guidelines

Full fees will be paid for:

- Game played
- Partial game played (weather, forfeit, etc.)
- Forfeit game
- Game canceled without enough (2 hours) notice or no notice. Includes rescheduled games with no notice.
- Game canceled at field due to bad field condition. (Coach should know condition of field beforehand)

Partial fee (\$5.00) will be paid for:

- Fields open. Weather goes bad late afternoon not sufficient time to cancel. No one's fault.

Plate fee plus half base fee will be paid for:

- All cases where full fee would be paid but only one Umpire is present. The Umpire is paid the full plate fee plus half the base fee even if a volunteer helps with the bases.

## UMPIRE ASSIGNER AGREEMENT

Between Cole Harbour Minor Baseball Association and Kenneth Hartling, Umpire Assigner.

The following outlines the responsibilities and procedures of the Association and the Assigner:

- The Assigner will be responsible to assign two Registered Baseball Umpires when possible to all regular and playoff home games of all House League and Rep League Teams (up to and including Midget AA) of the Association. This will not include Provincial Playdowns or National Elimination Events.
- The Assigner will not be responsible for the failure of umpires to appear on time and/or at their assigned games. Association Coaches should contact the Assigner following any games in which there were shortages of umpires or lateness of appearance of umpires so that the appropriate action can be taken with the Umpire-in-chief.
- The Assigning fee for the season is the same as the one game fee for the two umpires. Payment should be forwarded to the Assigner no later than June 15. Failure to forward payment may result in the removal of Umpiring services to the offending teams until payments are made. For tournament games, fees will be on a case by case basis.
- When booking Umpires for rescheduled games, teams must give the Assigner at least forty-eight (48) hours notice of the requirements.
- When postponing games, teams must notify the Assigner at least two hours prior to game time. Preferably, more notice should be given. If postponement is made without notification to the Assigner or if the notification is beyond the notice deadline, the team or association may be liable to full payment of the umpires.
- When the Halifax Regional Municipality closes fields, the Assigner will contact the umpires to cancel the game assignments. No umpires will be dispatched to closed fields.
- The Association is to provide to the Assigner a full schedule of games and a full list of team coaches or contacts and telephone numbers as early as possible before the season starts. Any changes to the schedules and/or coaches are to be provided to the Assigner by the Association as soon as they are known.
